# Tonkin Gap Project and Associated Works

## Local schools

### What work is happening?

As part of the Tonkin Gap Project and Associated Works the team is upgrading Broun Avenue bridge to a new longer and wider structure that will accommodate traffic lanes and a bus interchange, for Morley Station to eventually be built in the Tonkin Highway median and form part of the new Morley-Ellenbrook Line.

Modifications to the existing Broun Avenue bridge are not possible and therefore the existing bridge will need to be deconstructed and rebuilt.

To allow for the deconstruction work to be completed safely, the team will close Tonkin Highway in both directions between Morley Drive and Collier Road

Broun Ave will also be closed between Embleton Avenue and Beechboro Road North for 28 days to allow works to be safely undertaken on the bridge.

We encourage road users to plan ahead and use the detours in place.

### Road closures

- Full closure of Broun Avenue from the evening of the 29 March and will remain closed until the evening of the 26 April (open after the long weekend).
- Full closure of Tonkin Highway - Night of 1 April to morning of 4 April (Friday to Monday)

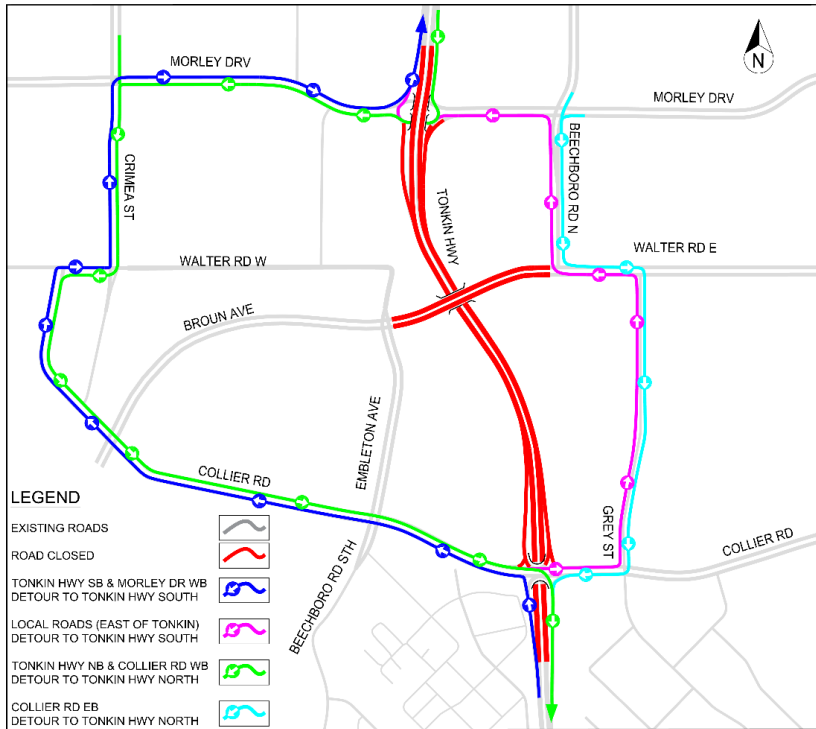
### School impacts
