Dear Students/Parents/Guardians/Staff

The College Principal, Mr John Bormolini, in his *Letter to Community – Term 4 2021*, mentioned that the College will be undertaking a review of the College Uniform. Please note that this review will consider various elements with a view to improvement and not necessarily wholesale change, more of a refresh than a redesign.

Throughout this process we are mindful of numerous elements including cost, equity, fabric, comfort, gender-neutrality, practicality, non-negotiables (eg College colours), timeless design and CEWAs Modern Slavery Prevention Executive Directive. As you can appreciate, the process will be extensive and the timeline/phase-in period for implementation is yet to be determined, dependent also on the impact of COVID-19 on suppliers.

This process has commenced with the formation of the Uniform Review Committee (members noted below) and continues now by seeking further input via an online questionnaire. This will be emailed to a select cross section from our community that includes students and their parents/guardians from different year groups through PCGs, staff, Parent Engagement Group and College Advisory Council.

Hopefully the survey won't take up too much time, we anticipate around 15 minutes, and responses are not only necessary but also appreciated. Finally, there will be space for comment if required. Thank you in advance to those who will be invited to participate.
