Year 7 – 2026

The Principal invites parents and caregivers of students **entering Year 7 in 2026** to apply on behalf of their child for a Music Scholarship. Each Scholarship is **tenable for Years 7 to 12** and will subsidise the cost of music tuition fees.

Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of a student's written application, an audition and an interview. When selecting scholarship allocations and instrumental positions, the College will consider the following:

- Applicant's musical aptitude
- Applicant's dedication
- Extenuating Circumstances (eg. Family Hardship)
- The overall needs of the College Music Department

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INFORMATION SHEET

Chisholm Catholic College will offer Music Scholarships for students entering Year 7 in 2026.

1. The Scholarships

The Director of Music, in conjunction with the Principal, awards a number of Music Scholarships at the commencement of each year. Following the successful acceptance of application (via the appropriate form available from the enrolment registrar and **submitted by Friday 28 March 2025**) prospective candidates are invited for an audition and interview. Successful awardees are notified in writing following the conclusion of the process. Auditions will occur in **Early Term 3**.

2. Audition Requirements

- Performance:
 1. Basic aural assessment
 2. Two contrasting pieces
- Interview:

Both students and parent/s are required to be present for an interview with the Director of Music.

3. Application Requirements

- Completed written application.
- Relevant supporting documentation eg music reports
- Contact details of current music teacher/s who are prepared to endorse your application if contacted

4. Music Program Requirements

The successful applicants:

- Will attend individual lessons on their instrument for the duration of their time at Chisholm College.
- Will be required to participate in College music activities as deemed appropriate by the Director of Music.
- Will be required to participate in the following ensemble and timetabled classes at Chisholm Catholic College:

Year 7:

An extra-curricular ensemble held once per week.

Years 8 to 10:

Music Studies class as part of their timetabled classes and an extra- curricular ensemble held once per week.

- In addition to the above, the successful applicants will demonstrate:
 - i. a positive commitment to their academic studies;
 - ii. a positive attitude in alignment with the ethos of Chisholm Catholic College;
 - iii. an appropriate behaviour record; and
 - iv. an excellent attendance record.
- Successful applicants will meet with the Director of Music at the end of each year to review that the scholarship requirements are being upheld; in interview and/or audition format, to be communicated by the Director of Music.

5. Process of Awarding Scholarships

- The Principal, in conjunction with the Director of Music, will make the final decision based on the results of the written application, audition, interview and needs of the College. No correspondence will be entered into.
- The College reserves the right to decide whether a scholarship will be awarded.

6. Notification

- Students who are offered a scholarship will be notified by mail.
